Geology: the study of the Earth's history

James Hutton:

- Said the Earth's landforms are constantly changing
- **Uniformitarianism:** geologic processes shaping the Earth today have been at work throughout Earth's history
 - Nobody believed him
 - People believed the Earth was only thousands of years old
- Catastrophism: geologic changes occur suddenly
 - Most scientists believed in this concept
 - o Rare, sudden events are called *catastrophes*
- Later scientists found out that geologic changes occur gradually not sudden

Catastrophic events do occur occasionally

• Asteroid that lead to the extinction of the dinosaurs
